









Squirrel Class Home Learning – Term 3 Spring 2025

Include labels to help people understand.</p> 
<p>Become an engineer Design and build a small junk model and become an engineer like Brunel.</p> 	<p>Setting goals Following our learning in Jigsaw set a goal to learn a new skill. Think about the small steps needed to achieve the goal.</p> 	<p>Create a Biome in a box Grab a box and create a pretend biome/habitat in a box.</p>
