Home Learning in Year 3

Spelling: Your child will receive regular spellings to practise at home. Please support your child with this. The spellings will be posted on Seesaw weekly. Spellings will be tested informally every Tuesday in class.

Reading: This is an ongoing activity that we would anticipate children do 5 days a week. This is both independent reading and reading aloud to an adult. Please record on Seesaw when your child reads. This can be simply recorded as a list of when a child has read or could also be in the form of a video or a book review

Wider Curriculum: At the beginning of terms 1, 3 and 5, your child will be given a grid of activities to choose from, based mainly on their topic. This will be put on Seesaw this week. At the beginning of terms 2, 4 and 6, a grid of activities with more of a writing focus on it will be put on Seesaw.

Maths: Please practise times tables and corresponding division facts to recall at speed. Please support your child to practise their times tables on TT Rockstars a couple of times a week. The children should have their usernames and passwords but please ask if you don't have them. By the end of **year 3**, children need to know 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10x tables.

Weekly maths home learning related to what they are doing in class will be posted on Seesaw every F<mark>riday.</mark> They will then go through this in class every Friday. Please support your child with this at home.
